The Apopka Police Department has received a high number of traffic complaints recently. Many of them involve parking along the roadway/streets. Please take a few minutes to refamiliarize yourself with the City of Apopka's traffic ordinances. - ***78-37(2) Must be parked in the direction of traffic (no left wheels to curb).
- ***78-37(2) Must park within 12 inches of edge of pavement.
- 78-37(4) Parked over line designated for parking space.
- 78-37(5) Abandoned.
- 78-37(6) Dismantled or junked vehicle parked on road or right-of-way.
- ***78-38(1) Must leave 12 feet of lane width if parked on roadway.
- ***78-38(2) On-street parking prohibited when practicable to park in driveway.
- 78-38(3) Must be a clear view of vehicle parked in roadway from a distance of 200'.
- 78-38(4) Parked in an alley.
- ****78-38(5) Parked on a curve.
- ****78-39(1) Within 15' of a community mailbox except momentarily to drop off mail, between the hours of 8am and 6pm excluding Sundays and federal holidays. Within fifteen (15) feet of a single mail box between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., excluding Sunday and Federal Holidays unless the vehicle has a valid registration which lists the street address on which the mail box is located.
- ***78-39(2) Blocking access to commercial or residential refuse container.
- 8-39(3) Red or yellow painted curb.
- 78-39(4) Disabled only parking. \$250 within five business days; \$260 thereafter.
- 78-39(4)(b) Obstructing disabled accessible parking space, curb cut, or access aisle. \$250 within five business days; \$260 thereafter.
- 78-39(5) Within curved area of a cul-de-sac.
- ***78-39(6) Within an intersection or within 30 feet of an intersection approach.
- 78-39(10) In front of, across from, or along the curb within 12 feet of a public or private driveway, except to momentarily pick-up or drop-off passengers.
- 78-39(11) On a sidewalk or with any part of the vehicle protruding over the sidewalk.
- 78-39(13) Wrong way on a one-way street.
- 78-39(14) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or within 20 feet of a fire station entrance.
- 78-39(15) Within any fire lane. 78-39(17) Along a bicycle or walking path.
- 78-39(21) Within any space designated for an emergency vehicle.
- 78-39(22) Within or on a median.
- 78-40 Parking where prohibited by sign or marking.
- 78-41(3) Parking on street for purposes of washing or polishing a vehicle. Temporary non-profit entity car washes exempted.
- ***78-41(4) Parking upon any street, alley, parking lot or residential area for the principal purpose of displaying advertising.
- 78-47(1) Park a vehicle upon any street, right-of-way, or any private parking area open to the public, without a current and valid registration license plate and validation sticker.
